Chelmsford is the County Town and administrative centre of the UK County of Essex, which is situated to the North East of London. Although not recognised yet as a "City" the town has a Cathedral which controls the second largest diocese in the UK, the Anglia Ruskin University, the home of the Essex County Cricket Team and a number of important listed buildings (including our venue The Shire Hall). It is perhaps most famous as being the place where Marconi completed his experiments with radio and eventually set up the first radio manufacturing factory in the world and the site of the first commercial radio broadcast in the world.

Of course in recent times it has become well know as the venue for the 21st (Centenary) World Scout Jamboree in 2007 and there will be an opportunity to visit the "One World Garden" which was erected to commemorate this event.

In Scouting terms "Chelmsford and District" is part of the Essex Scout County and with well over 2,000 members is the largest District in the UK.

In Guiding terms there are two District, Chelmsford North and Chelmsford South, both of which are extremely successful and which are planning many events for 2010 as part of the Guiding Centenary celebrations.

We anticipate that assistance will be forthcoming from both Movements during the EuroScout 2010.

Whilst not generally recognised as a "tourist centre", Chelmsford does get a regular visitor population and on the following page you will find a schedule of the local hotels, Guest Houses and "Bed and Breakfast" facilities. Please make direct contact with them to book any required accommodation. So far only the County Hotel, which is also the venue for the Gala Dinner, has offered special terms if you book and refer to EuroScout 2010.


